

RETURNING TO WORK AFTER CANCER: SUBJECTIVE EXPERIENCE OF EMPLOYEES

Project implementation period: 2018–2019

Objective of the research: to disclose employees' experiences of returning to work after cancer

Tasks:

1. To analyze and to describe the study participants' experiences of returning to work after cancer.
2. To analyze factors, that enhance and hinder the return to work of cancer survivors.

Study methodology: qualitative research, based on Braun & Clarke's methodology for thematic analysis. Semi-structured form of the interview will be used in this research. Interview questions will be presented based on interview plan and the list of questions compiled by research authors. Demographic data will be addressed as well.

Based on the results of the research, methodological recommendations for employers and human resource specialists on organizing supportive return to work programs will be prepared.

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
